



## **IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR TURF BURN PARTICIPANTS**

### **GAME TIMES / TOURNAMENT SCHEDULE**

- Games will begin exactly at scheduled times (see schedule for details)
- Please ensure that your team is warmed up and ready to go prior to the previous game finishing, as there will be very limited changeover time between games.
- Tournament will be played on grass fields, so please bring appropriate footwear. Metal studs are not allowed.
- The playoff draw will be made immediately following the final round of games on Saturday. Playoffs on Sunday only.

### **ROSTERS AND WAIVERS**

- **All Players must read and understand the “TURF BURN 2017 RULES.” It is the responsibility of the Captain to ensure their team understand the rules and eligibility requirements.**
- Each team is allowed to sign a maximum of 15 players *including the keeper*.
- Rosters must be submitted along with signed waivers for every player prior to your first game.
- During play, there must be a minimum of 3 female players on the field at all times, *not including the keeper*
- During Round Robin play, a player will be permitted to play for multiple teams, provided that the player is included on the submitted roster for all teams playing on.
- During the Round Robin, and right up until the start of the playoffs, a team who loses a player may replace the lost player(s). **Example:** if a team starts with 15 players, but 2 players become injured during the tournament, that team may pick up 2 players, provided the playoffs have not already begun
- Once the playoffs begin, a player will be considered “Cup Tied” - the first team played for during playoffs will be the team the player is considered to be part of. A player cannot play for multiple teams during the playoffs.
- Once a team has been eliminated from the playoffs, the players of the eliminated team cannot join other teams.

### **PARKING**

- There is plenty of parking next to the Juan de Fuca Fields and around the *Q Centre*. Please be respectful of local traffic, speed signs, and parking spot designations.
- Juan de Fuca Site Staff are aware that it may be necessary for tournament participants to leave their cars on site overnight.
